Iconic flavor combinations such as "Ispahan" and "Mogador" as well as seasonal creations will be offered at the latest boutique in Macau but not only macarons – indulgent chocolates, unique confectionery treats, sumptuous cakes and more are to be discovered at the Studio City boutique.

"I am delighted at the opportunity to bring the Pierre Hermé Paris experience to Macau," explained Chef Hermé. "Studio City and the Studio City Boulevard is the perfect place in Macau to discover my universe of tastes, sensations and pleasures."

Chef Hidemasa Yamamoto has opened his first restaurant in Macau, 'Hide Yamamoto', at Studio City. He revealed the new restaurant's four authentic dining



experiences serve guests a taste of market fresh fish flown in daily from Tsukiji market at the sushi bar; a sizzling, tasty, teppanyaki; the highest quality Japanese ingredients including wagyu grilled to perfection at the robata station; and homemade ramen prepared through a 110-year-old traditional technique.
